

Available Clinics for Kindergarten

Required for Kindergarten Registration:

- Birth certificate or an I-94 Resident Alien (*Green*) Card.
- Record of Immunizations: The month, day, and year received or a certificate from a physician or public health clinic indicating immunizations have been received for the following:
 - ✓ Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis - 5 doses, unless the 4th dose was given after the age of 4
 - ✓ Oral Polio - 4 doses, unless the 3rd dose was given after the age of 4
 - ✓ Measles, Mumps, Rubella - 2 doses given after age 12 months
 - ✓ Hepatitis B – 3 doses
 - ✓ Varicella – 2 doses or had detected disease (*Chicken Pox*).

No student is required to receive an immunization if they have a medical contraindication, laboratory evidence of immunity, or if receiving an immunization is contrary to conscientiously held beliefs. For more information about exemptions, please call 651-632-3763.
- Results of Early Childhood Screening or comprobable screening.
 - ✓ Call 651-632-3746 for an appointment.
 - ✓ Early Childhood Screening is required for children before Kindergarten by the State of Minnesota. The target age is 4 years old.

Recommended for Kindergarten Registration:

1. Physical Examination
2. Dental Examination

The National Congress of Parents and Teachers, the American Medical Association, and the American Dental Association stress a “Program for Continuous Health Supervision of Children” from birth through high school to safeguard the health of children at all ages. The Saint Paul Public Schools Student Health and Wellness program follows these recommendations, as they apply to all children entering preschool or Kindergarten, by urging parents to obtain a Health Examination from their primary health care provider.

Birth Certificate: A certified copy of the birth record of a child born in the City of St. Paul can be obtained by coming to Vital Records at the Public Health Department. A \$16 fee will be charged; additional copies are \$9. (*If you need this record, be sure to apply before August 1.*) For information, call 651-266-1333.
